Training

As part of the training we will use drama techniques such as Hot seating, Forum Theatre and Role-Play to find solutions and explore positive outcomes. PPA Cover

Apple Pie utilises drama in education to provide PPA cover within schools. The PPA cover can enhance your school's curriculum in areas such as Literacy, History and PSHE or it can be used to teach young people drama skills. All sessions will use interactive drama techniques such as still images, hot seating, teacher-in-role and role-play to explore the topics your school is currently teaching.

Peer Support Training

Peer support schemes enable chosen young people to learn the communication skills needed to be able to support their fellow pupils. The program equips pupils with the skills needed to help others reach decisions about difficulties they may be facing. Peer support can be used as a way for pupils to resolve minor issues (freeing up teaching time) and also as a pathway for pupils to dealing with serious issues such as Bullying. Your school will be advised on how to initially set up the scheme and how to maintain the scheme following the training.
